

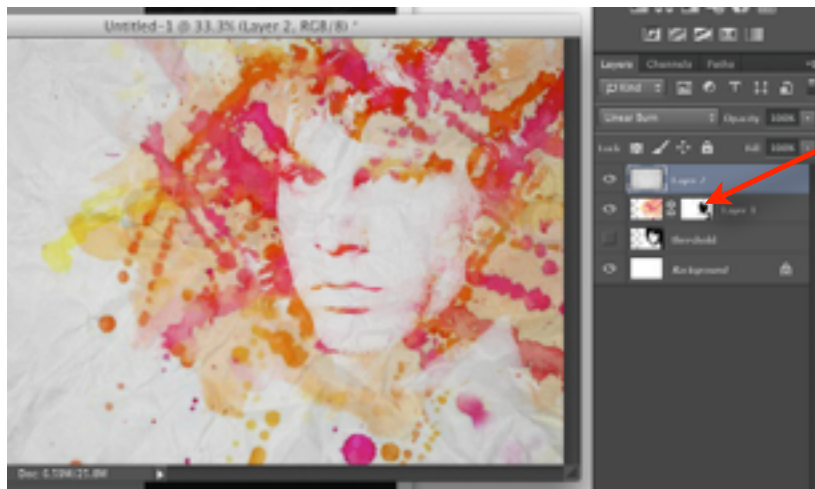
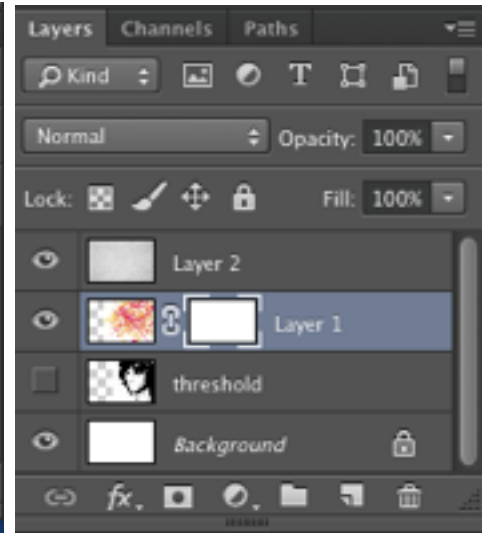
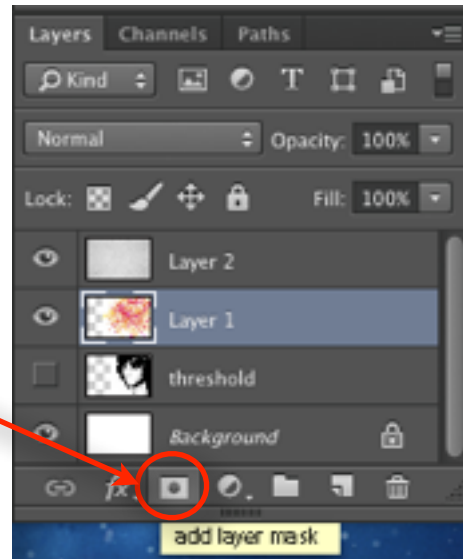
Type of portrait: Watercolor Portrait

Tool/ Technique Used: Layer Mask

Here, the layer mask is going to allow the watercolor layer to only come through in the shape of Jim Morrison's face

Click here to add a layer mask to the watercolor layer



1. Copy the image of Jim Morrison
2. ALT click on the white Layer Mask (everything will go white)
3. Hit Command + V to paste his face
4. Hit Command + I to invert it
5. Hit Command + D to deselect

Layer Masks allow you to PAINT IN the image or Paint it out (like the quick mask!) This way if you erase some, you do not loose it (called [Non-Destructive](#)) Use a brush, use black and white to paint more of the watercolor effect in or out. x swaps between a black and white brush
